Digital printing

Digital printing uses the latest digital inkjet technology to reproduce your artwork in its entirety to garment.

It uses an 'airbrush' type method to apply specially formulated water-based inks, allowing the most intricate detail, colour and designs to textile.

Inks are long-lasting, flexible, crack and fade resistant.

What are the benefits of a 'digital print'?

Financially viable for smaller print runs

Print or trail multiple designs- unit price is determined by TOTAL amount ordered with a \$15.00 design fee per artwork change.

Reproduces the most intricate of detail – photographs, watercolour, shading etc.

Screen printing

Using the finest of mesh, ink is squeegeed across a screen to fill the open mesh apertures creating an image to garment. Each colour is applied one at a time, several screens can be used to produce a multicolour image or design.
